# **CCW Course for Tulare County offered by MLS Firearms**

On January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 the California Legislature broadly increased the training requirements to obtain a Conceal Carry permit, requiring a minimum of 8 hours of training as well as requiring Sheriffs to establish demonstrated Weapons Qualification as a part of the class. In Tulare County, the Sheriff has established new CCW class requirements of 4 hours of Classroom and 4 hours at the Shooting Range. In addition, the Weapon Proficiency Qualification requirement is: a minimum 50% of rounds from a single full magazine or cylinder to hit a target from a distance of 7 yards. This must be demonstrated for each handgun the applicant wishes to include or renew on their CCW permit.

**8 Hours total:** 4 Hours Classroom

4 Hours at the Shooting Range

#### What to bring:

- One "Main" handgun for the Range Training
- 250 rounds of ammunition for your Main weapon.
- One Outside-the-Waistband Holster for your Main weapon.
- Any additional handguns (up to 4 total included, plus \$5.00 each additional) you want to list on your CCW
- Enough ammunition for each additional handgun to load at least one full magazine or cylinder. (NOTE: Enough ammunition for 3 "loads" is recommended, since you will be given three chances to qualify.)

### **CCW Renewal Class:**

**4 Hours total:** 2 Hours Classroom

2 Hours at the Shooting Range

#### What to bring:

- One "Main" handgun for the Range Training
- 100 rounds of ammunition for your Main weapon.
- Any additional handguns (up to 4 total included, plus \$5.00 each additional) you want to list on your CCW
- Enough ammunition for each additional handgun to load at least one full magazine or cylinder. (NOTE: Enough ammunition for 3 "loads" is recommended, since you will be given three chances to qualify.)

Cost: \$70
